PARK MAP






You're standing on the spot where a million imaginations have been unleashed.

23 magical story boxes are located at various playsets around the park. Insert your special key in one

direction, and you'll hear a story. Insert the key in the other direction, and you'll hear a song. It's a wonderful way to augment your child's visit and educate them on classic fairytales and nursery rhymes. The keys are available for rent at the box office.
